Mayor and Council Minutes
June 22, 2026

The City of Byron Mayor and Council met in special session at 10:00am in the Office of the Mayor at the Municipal Complex. Mayor Michael Chidester and Council Members James Richardson, Michael Chumbley, Rusty Adams, Alan Dorsey, and Chris Hodges were in attendance. City employees that attended were City Administrator Tiffany Sandefur, City Clerk Telina Allred, and Police Chief Wesley Cannon. Two (2) visitors came to the meeting, however no representatives from the media were in attendance.

Mayor Michael Chidester called the meeting to order at 10:00am.

RESOLUTION REGARDING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FY2025: City Administrator Tiffany Sandefur explained that the adjustment was needed regarding Stormwater. Motion made by Michael Chumbley, seconded by Chris Hodges to approve the following Resolution authorizing a Supplemental Appropriation regarding the FY2025 Audit. Unanimous. Also, Police Chief Wesley Cannon spoke briefly on stormwater and updated all on drainage issues around the Byron Library that are currently being repaired.

All Resolutions or portions of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
